

Misha's Vineyard 'The Gallery' Gewürztraminer 2011



18.5/20 \bigstar \bigstar \bigstar \bigstar \bigstar **5** stars "80% cool-fermented in stainlesssteel, 20% warm-fermented by indigenous yeasts in old French oak to 14.0% alc. and 11 g/L rs. Brilliant, very pale straw colour with green hues, pale on rim. The nose is one of refinement, tightly bound with delicate exotic florals and rose petal aromas, along with subtle, but definite lines of spice. Medium-dry, this is very finely proportioned and tight in expression, with intense rose petal and blossom flavours. The palate is silky-smooth with a very fine and slippery mouthfeel that is soft, round and balanced by delicate, lacy acidity. The depth of fruit and linear drive carries the florals and spice notes to a long and lingering finish. This is a Gewurztraminer with finesse & intensity to match with salmon, poultry and cheeses over the next 3-4 years". (Raymond Chan, Raymond Chan Wine Reviews)

Already delicious, it's an enticingly fragrant wine, offering fresh, strong, vibrant flavours of lychees, pears and spices, a gentle splash of sweetness (11 grams/litre of residual sugar) and lovely delicacy and depth."
