



Misha's Vineyard 'The High Note' Pinot Noir 2012

18+/20 "Even ruby-red colour with slight garnet hues, pale edged. The nose is fresh and bright with fine proportions of aromatic red cherry fruit lifted by red florals. This has a tight core unfolding red liquorice and thyme herb notes, along with spices and minerals. Medium-bodied, the palate is juicy and succulent with lively and vibrant flavours of red cherries, lifted by red florals, and entwined with red liquorice, spice notes and mineral nuances. The mouthfeel is elegant with light, fine, supple tannin extraction, and enlivened by softly fresh, lacy acidity. This has freshness, drive and energy that carries the wine to a fragrant red cherry fruited and floral finish. This is an elegant, fragrant, sweet-fruited Pinot Noir with red cherry, liquorice and floral flavours and supple tannins and fresh acidity. Serve with antipasto, with Asian fare, poultry and pork dishes over the next 5 years. Clones 45% 4, 45% 5 & 10% 777, given a cold soak and indigenous yeast fermented to 13.5% alc., the wine spending 23 Days on skins & aged 18 months in 27% new 300 L hogsheads. 94/100 ★ ★ ★ ★ ★ **5 stars** "Generous aroma filled Pinot Noir bouquet with suggestions of ripe light red fruits and spices of oak; loads of cherry and wild raspberry tones, crushed rose and rocky mineral moments. On the palate - dry, plenty of spice then fruit in the attack, tense and focused tannins & acidity add key structural layers contrasting the core of fruit mid-palate; the oak is fresh, youthful and beginning to integrate through the juice adding to the complexity

and length - both are significant. A long finish - tense and young. Decant for service a few hours ahead of a main meal or wait then enjoy from 2019 through 2027." **(Cameron Douglas, Master Sommelier)**
