



Misha's Vineyard 'Dress Circle' Pinot Gris 2019

95/100 ★ ★ ★ ★ ★ "The refined 2019 vintage (5*) was estate-grown at Bendigo and 42 per cent of the blend was fermented with indigenous yeasts in old French oak hogsheads. Made in an off-dry style (6.3 grams/litre of residual sugar), it is highly scented and strongly varietal. Bright, light lemon/green, it is mouthfilling, with rich, vibrant pear, lychee and spice flavours, a very subtle oak influence, fresh, balanced acidity and a very harmonious finish. 94/100 "Fragrant, pure, fruity and varietal with aromas of pomaceous fruits - sweet green pear and red apple, white spice of pepper, a soft lees moment with a gentle whit-beer note and creamy texture completing the bouquet. Flavours on the palate reflect the nose with white fleshed fruits and some white spice, a generous core, youthful acidity and warmth. Balanced, well made and lengthy finish.
