★ ★ ★ ★ ★ "The 2019 vintage (4.5\*) was estate-grown and hand-picked on 6 June at Bendigo, in Central Otago, at 30.2 brix, with 15 per cent of the fruit botrytis-affected and hand-dried without oak. Pale lemon/green, with an invitingly perfumed, gently spicy bouquet, it is an elegant, light-bodied style (9.5 per cent alcohol), with very youthful, vibrant, citrusy, spicy flavours, showing excellent delicacy and depth, and a sweet (120 grams/litre of residual sugar), smooth finish. A very harmonious wine, it is well worth cellaring; best drinking 2021+." Sep 2019 (Michael Cooper, Buyer's Guide to New Zealand Wine)

**94/100** "Fragrant, pure, fruity and varietal with aromas of pomaceous fruits - sweet green pear and red apple, white spice of pepper, a soft lees moment with a gentle white-beer note and creamy texture completing the bouquet. Flavours on the palate reflect the nose with white fleshed fruits and some white spice, a generous core, youthful acidity and warmth. Balanced, well made and lengthy finish.
