**4.5 Stars** ★ ★ ★ ★ ★ *"The 2018 vintage (4.5\*) was estate-grown at Bendigo and fermented in seasoned French oak barrels, partly (25 per cent) with indigenous yeasts. Bright, light yellow/green, it is mouthfilling, with concentrated, ripe, peachy, gently spicy flavours, showing very good complexity, fresh acidity and an off-dry (14 grams/litre residual sugar), finely balanced finish.
