


Misha's Vineyard 'Limelight' Riesling 2016

96/100 "Totally enticing bouquet of Riesling with captivating aromas of mandarin and lime-flower, green tea and green apple. Additional aromas of white blossoms and white rose, a fine mineral layer with quartz and wet stone suggested. Off-dry on the palate with an immediate sweetness contrasted by high acidity bringing forward flavours of mandarin and pineapple, lime-flower and peach. A delicious wine worthy of your attention and cellar or refrigerator. Enjoy now and through 2026+. Aug 2019" (Cameron Douglas, MS)

5 Stars \Rightarrow \Rightarrow \Rightarrow \Rightarrow \Rightarrow "This single-vineyard wine is hand-harvested at Bendigo, in Central Otago. Lovely now, the 2016 vintage (5*) was made in a medium style (29 grams/litre of residual sugar), with complexity gained by fermenting 24 per cent of the blend with indigenous yeasts in old French oak barrels. Bright, light lemon/green, it is richly scented and vivacious, with deep, lemony, appley, slightly peachy flavours, gentle sweetness balanced by mouth-watering acidity, and a finely poised, lasting finish. Best drinking 2021+. (Tasted in early 2018, the 2011 vintage (5*) is unfolding superbly, with a powerful surge of peachy, citrusy flavour, bottleaged notes adding complexity, and a long, very harmonious finish.).
