residual sugar), with complexity gained by fermenting 27 per cent of the blend with indigenous yeasts in old French oak barrels. Bright, light lemon/green, it is light and lively, with excellent intensity of citrusy, slightly appley flavours, showing good delicacy, and a lovely balance of gentle sweetness and appetising acidity. citrus and tree fruits to reflect the nose. Lemongrass and lime-flower then lemon and hints of lime. The nose is softly-full, inviting and elegantly presented, aromas of crunchy green apple, lime juice and zest, elderflower and mineral notes. Medium-bodied, medium dry to taste, nuances of green apple, lime juice and zest have ripeness and balance, subtle elderflower floral and mineral unveil, linger with aniseed and crisp acidity. The sugar provides a plush palate, along with threads of slightly chalky phenolic. Acidity and sugar are in perfect balance, leaves the palate with a flavoursome, refreshing closing. Match with spicy Asian and Mexican fare over the next 6+ years. Handpicked, whole bunch pressed, free-run juice (73%) fermented cool in stainless steel, the rest of pressings fermented in older French oak in warmer temperatures. 11% alc, 31 g/l RS."
