**5 Stars** ★ ★ ★ ★ ★ “Instantly appealing, the 2021 vintage (5\*) was made from Pinot Noir, estate-grown at Bendigo and mostly handled in tanks; 5 per cent of the blend was fermented in seasoned oak barrels. The palate displays excellent fruit vibrancy together with creamy mouthfeel and refreshing acidity, offering terrific drinking. **93/100** “Bright, pale neon-pink colour, even colour throughout. The nose is softly full and vibrant, packed with aromas of field berries, pink peppercorn, lemonade, red florals and suggestions of strawberry flavoured confectionery. Medium-light bodied, dry-ish to taste, fresh nuances of strawberries, cranberries, cherries lifted by lemonade, lemon peels, along with red flower petals linger to a mouth-watering, juicy finish. The fruit has good concentration and flavours,

contribute to a lovely weight on the palate; subtle fine-textured phenolic added a silky mouthfeel, supported by lively acidity. This is a juicy Pinot Rosé with field berries flavours, adorned with a smooth texture and peppery details. Match with Thai beef salad and venison salami over the next 2-3 years. The fruit was destemmed, crushed, soaked for an average of 24 hours on skins.
