"Bright, straw-yellow with some depth, lighter on the rim. The bouquet is appealing and full, aromas of ripe peach, lychee and guava entwined with raw honey, rose petals and a hint of ginger. Medium-full bodied, concentrated aromas of guava, lychee melded with ripe peach, honey, subtle spice, and rose petals lends a lingering finish. The flavours are harmonious and well-proportioned; brilliantly balanced with sugar and acidity; lively acidity refreshes the palate with a hint of gingery spice. The low alcohol content makes it effortlessly approachable. Match with chicken liver parfait and panna cotta over the next 5+ years. "The 2021 vintage (4.5) was estate-grown and late-picked by hand at Bendigo, in Central Otago. with less than 5 per cent of the fruit botrytis-affected, and handled without oak. Pale straw, with an invitingly perfumed, spicy bouquet, it is light-bodied (9.5 per cent alcohol), with pear, lychee and spice flavours, showing excellent delicacy and vibrancy, and a sweet (131 grams/litre of residual sugar), soft finish.
