Aromas and flavours of lemon and fresh red apple, there's a combination of cape gooseberry and fresh green herbs, there's a steely mineral quality as the wine

develops in glass and with a light savoury quality this is a wine that shows myriad attributes simultaneously. Taut and dry with a plenty of acidity giving a salivating palate squeeze, flavours are persistent with a saline touch on the finish. An excellent example from the region. 4.5 stars \bigstar \bigstar \bigstar "Full of youthful drive, the 2023 vintage was estate-grown at Bendigo, in the Cromwell Basin. Hand-picked, it was mostly handled in tanks, but 36 per cent of the blend was fermented with indigenous yeasts in

mostly older French oak casks (with some use of new oak). Bright, light lemon/green, it is weighty and finely textured, with strong peach, passionfruit, lime and capsicum flavours, showing very good complexity, and a dryish (5 grams/litre of residual sugar), lingering finish.
