2022 Riesling Limelight

The 2022 Riesling Limelight might be medium-dry in style but the way it finishes is just so tidy and textural that you want to go back again and again. It's succulent, shapely and structured thanks to phenolics and firm acidity providing a france of tension. It may not be as intriguing aromatically nor as vivacious as the 2023 right now but it has concentration, balance and excellent texture. Apple, citrus and warming spice notes linger on the finish. 11% alcohol.

The 2023 Riesling Limelight is a vivid wine style full of sunshine, brightness and a vibrant, perky nature. Clean, bright citrus and crisp apple flavours are joined by exotic floral and spice notes, as if you've just walked into some Middle Eastern bazaar. A splash of sweetness gives it a welcoming entrance before ending with a clean, refreshing finish. The final impression is pure, precise and perfumed. It's very invigorating. No need to wait to drink this but it should age gracefully in case you forget to drink it. Good luck resisting!

2023 Riesling Lyric

The 2023 Riesling Lyric has a sappy, lip-smacking style featuring notes of lemon, lime, apple and floral talc. While a mere touch of residual sugar provides welcoming flesh on the entry, the finish is long, dry, tense and grippy. While this is a little phenolic and firm rather than delicate, time will likely be its friend.

2023 Gewurztraminer The Gallery

Full and curved yet precise and pure, Misha's 2023 Gewurztraminer The Gallery, has a dry serious, concentrated expression. It has the essence of a wine whose aromatic exuberance has had time to settle and should be enjoyed in the next couple of years for its rosewater, sushi ginger and candied orange peel notes. The 2023 is scented and medium-long.

2024 Gewurztraminer The Cadenza

There's no mistaking the variety in this 2024 Gewurztraminer Late Harvest The Cadenza. Its inimitable lychee, rose petal and ginger fragrances linger long. The 2024 is unctuous and mouthcoating with gentle acidity. I advise serving this well chilled to give it greater tension and focus. Enjoy this in its first years for its aromatics.
